As Mersive's sole focus, Solstice offers industry-leading ease of use, performance, and user capabilities while Crestron AirMedia has low overall usability scores and primarily targets vendor lock-in. Unlike AirMedia, Solstice promotes inclusive collaboration by allowing participants to share any amount of content and easily control the layout using a customizable, intuitive drag-and-drop interface.
